New ANSA McAL Foundation Chairman



The ANSA McAL Foundation welcomes a new chairman in the person of Mr Andrew Sabga, the third son of our founder, Dr Anthony N Sabga. The foundation funds the ANSA Caribbean Awards.

Mr (A) Sabga takes over the chairmanship of the foundation from his brother, Mr Norman Sabga, who remains the patron of the Anthony N Sabga Caribbean Awards for Excellence. Mr Andrew Sabga is the Deputy Chairman of the ANSA McAL Group of Companies. He was the Group Chief Executive Officer and the Chairman of the Executive Committee for the Parent Board and ANSA McAL Barbados from August 2017 to December 2019. He was the Deputy Chairman of the ANSA McAL Group from December 2015 to August 2017 and Beverage Sector Head from May 2007 to November 2015.

He has over 25 years of industry experience in the Manufacturing Sector of the Group, having previously held senior managerial positions and directorships at CARIB Brewery Limited, CARIB Glassworks Limited, Caribbean Development Co. Limited and Trinidad Match Limited. Mr Sabga was the former Chairman of Alstons Marketing, Caribbean Development Co. Limited, CARIB Brewery Limited, Grenada Breweries Limited, CARIB Brewery (St. Kitts & Nevis) Limited, DCI Miami, ANSA McAL (US) Inc and CARIB Glassworks Ltd.

He is a Director of ANSA McAL and was the President of the Trinidad and Tobago Chamber of Industry and Commerce from 2011 to 2013. He holds an MBA, Marketing, from the University of Miami and a B.Sc. in Business Administration (Marketing/Finance) from Boston University.

In memoriam, Sir Royston Hopkin



We were deeply saddened at the passing of Sir Royston Hopkin, a member of our Eminent Persons Panel, on February 22 in Trinidad.

He was the owner of the Spice Island Beach Resort in Grenada and had been involved in regional tourism for decades. He served on the Board of the Caribbean Hotel & Tourism Association (CHTA) since 1970.

Sir Royston was the recipient of several prestigious awards, including the coveted Caribbean Hotel Association's "Hotelier of the Year" honour in 1991. In 2006, he received the Grenada Board of Tourism's Tourism Nutmeg Award for his contribution to the local industry.

In 2009 the CHTA presented him with their Lifetime Achievement Award, and in January 2010, he was bestowed with the prestigious Star Diamond Award from the American Academy of Hospitality. In 2016 he received the Six Star Diamond Lifetime Achievement Award from the American Academy of Hospitality Sciences.

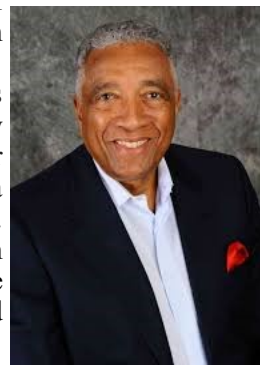
Outside of business, Sir Royston was one of the first Grenadians to establish a scholarship fund for needy children, when he adopted the Grand Anse R.C. School in 1992. Since

the establishment of the fund, 181 students have received scholarships.

In 2004, Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II elevated his rank to that of Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of St Michael and St George (KCMG) from CMG, which had been conferred in 1994.

Sir Royston was internationally known for his industry savvy. He was the former Chairman of the Caribbean Alliance for Sustainable Tourism (CAST), the largest private sector sustainable organization in the region. He was an Honorary Director of the Caribbean Hotel & Tourism Association, Honorary Director of the Grenada Hotel & Tourism Association and Vice Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Queen Elizabeth Home for Children.

He leaves his widow, Betty, The Lady Hopkin, and their children Ryan, Nerissa Janelle and Samantha. The funeral will be on March 5, at 1 p.m. at the Trade Centre, Grand Anse, Grenada.
